

# Sounds-Write

A synthetic phonics program to support the development of your child's reading, writing, and spelling skills.

## What is the Sounds-Write program?

The program starts with what children know from a young age – the sounds of spoken language. Then, using a very systematic approach, it teaches them how these sounds are coded within the writing system. Sounds-write is divided into two codes: initial code and extended code.

## What does the program involve?

The program will be run during the term for 10 weeks by a Sounds-Write Certified Speech Pathologist. There is a maximum of 4 students per group.

- ▶ 10 training sessions with same-aged and like-minded peers who are working on similar skills, offering an opportunity to build friendships.
- ▶ 5 multi-sensory activities per session aimed for maximising learning potential
- ▶ Decodable readers and activities for home practice provided after sessions to consolidate the knowledge learned.
- ▶ A summary of child's progress will be provided upon the completion of the last session.

## Cost:

It will cost approximately \$970 for the full 10 week program. The cost may vary depending on number of clinicians and participants. You may be eligible to use NDIS funding.
